

The Foxhound Pub

This property has been a public house since the late 18th century. Little is known about its history prior to this date but some say that used to house a local Assizes room.

The investigation was conducted on 14th September 2007 by two teams covering separate areas of the property.

The presence of a forlorn and desperately sad female was picked up independently by both teams' dowsers. All felt that she is in the window of the upstairs lounge. Some felt that she had died in childbirth and others that she was mourning the loss of a child. The presences of two happy playing children (a girl and boy) were felt in the kitchen.

Both teams investigated a large upstairs room which was under alteration and being re-furnished. This room had no electricity supply at the time but both teams picked up very high and unusual EMF readings in here. Three male presences were also sensed in this room and they appeared quite negative and didn't like us being in the room. The dowsers felt these men had been alive in the 1700-1800s and that this room had been used as a place of judgement. This room was particularly disorientating because of the lack of sufficient light and the uneven almost spongy floorboards. It gave the impression of phantom footsteps and creaks at the other end of the room. Some investigators photographed orbs or light anomalies in here although dust particles must be considered the cause.

In the downstairs bar areas several presences were sensed by the dowsers and other members of the team. A strong male energy was picked up in the main front doorway by almost all dowsers. One of the team felt that he had been murdered after an argument outside the pub. Some team members felt that they were being watched and felt cold blasts of air rush past them. One member even had her hair tugged in the back bar area.
