

Six pack of confidential locations

During the end of 2008 and the first quarter of 2009 as a group we have investigated 6 different properties within Cornwall, which have all been kept confidential at the venue or client's request.

As several of these have been repeat visits it has enabled us to follow cases over a longer period of time than usual; and also to trial different methods and devise the beginnings of a series of experiments.

In line with our policy of client/venue confidentiality we can't detail our findings here or showcase any photos. What we can say is returning to a venue offers the benefit of fresh eyes to previously experienced phenomenon and the chance to look further for rational explanations. Also the chance to experience repeat phenomenon, which happened significantly at 3 of the venues, this time with more investigators witnessing the unexplained goings on.

We weren't really able to offer any further explanations, but the opportunity to develop case files on locations and to build a bigger picture should never be ignored. After all a single night or day investigating alleged phenomenon fails to give a baseline or offer any comparison, was what the team experienced a one off? The only way to begin to address this is to return; ideally a series of 3 or more investigations should be conducted within a short period of time, although often this is impractical to the client. A compromise therefore is to return each year, or within 6 months where possible.

We plan to return to these locations and continue developing client relations, which despite requiring the group to maintain a low profile, offers invaluable development and hopefully a greater understanding of alleged paranormal phenomenon.
