

Confidential Location, Cornwall

Some members of the SI team have been to this location on several occasions and it proves quite popular due to the high level of activity and strange phenomenon. The investigation was held on 9th February 2008, and the details of the location are kept confidential at the owner's request.

On this occasion the team split themselves into two groups to cover as much of the building as possible. Downstairs in the main hall, a male presence was detected by one of the team. He appeared to be quite aggressive and didn't like us being in the hall. Orbs or light anomalies were caught on night vision camera in this area in response to questions that were asked by the team.

In the kitchen, several members of the team experienced strange phenomena. On entering the room to start the vigil some complained of a sulphur or rotten egg smell. The EMF readings in the storeroom off the kitchen were unusually high and no explanation could be found for this. The EMF readings in the kitchen also seem to fluctuate when asking out for a response. One team member detected a male presence in here and when they asked out for a sign that they were there, suddenly the back door in the kitchen flew open and security light in the yard came on. The manager of the site insists that the door opening would not trigger the light coming on and there was insufficient wind/ breeze to warrant the door flying open so violently.

The most active area of the building seemed to be upstairs. These rooms are used by a pigeon group who store cages for their birds. On entering the upper level to start the investigation, several members of the team heard a voice say 'coo-eee' and loud bang near the window. No one could explain this and there was no one around outside the building. The team experienced temperature drops, drained camera batteries, smells of body odour up here and the distinctive sound of a bird cage door rattling. During the vigil a séance was held and the team asked for a response to a question. Something was thrown in another room and on investigating the source of the noise a team member came across a warm coin. One team member felt that he had been 'taken over' by a presence for several minutes and felt he was unable to talk to the rest of the team. Thankfully this sensation left him when the séance was closed down. Several members picked up the presence of a young girl who had died in an accident and 2 male presences that used to work in the building. Light anomalies were seen in response to questions and one member had the top of her head touched.

Towards the end of the investigation the group decided to try some table tipping. This proved to be quite positive and at one point during the vigil only two members had their fingers on the table and it still moved vigorously.

Overall a very active and fascinating investigation at a venue SI are bound to visit again in the future.
